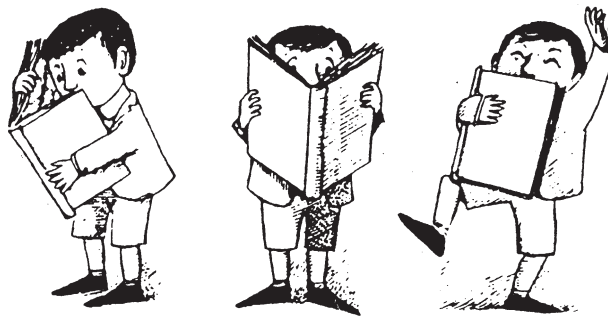

3. Your entry must be printed in ink or typed on white paper 8 1/2" x 11", **one side only, two pages or less. We are sorry; we cannot read more than two pages!** Write your name, address, grade, and school on your entry. Submit a copy of your story, not the original. Entries cannot be returned.
4. One entry per person.
5. No video or audio tape entries will be accepted.
